*I owe a lot to all of you. I joined 40Plus **dispirited, anxious, and confused** on how to land on my feet. All of you have been generous with encouragement.*

You've been my support system and I'm ever so grateful. Please let me know if I can do anything to help you out.

Many of you have been in that same anxious, dispirited and confused place yourselves, and know how much difference our **training, a fresh perspective, and a support and accountability system** can make. We want to share some more of Shel's story with you, in her words:

*I had been working in sales and business development for a small technology company for 12 years when I realized it was time to move on. **I wanted to expand my horizons and try something different, but the fear of the unknown kept me in place.** It wasn't until I'd hit the 16-year mark that I decided to leave and start looking for another job.*

***The landscape, however, had changed.** I quickly learned that my idea of how to find work was not going to work in today's job market.*

***What a relief it was to discover that I was not alone.** There were other people – like me – who didn't know how to navigate this job-hunting process, and all of them – like me – were eager to learn from each other as well as our 40Plus Facilitators. Through a combination of kindness, patience, understanding, and unrelenting encouragement, they helped all of us become more adept at presenting ourselves to prospective employers.*

***Three months after the course ended, I had a new job.** I now work for a much larger software company, and I love it. I respect my boss. My colleagues are terrific. I'm extraordinarily happy. This is where I want to be, and I couldn't have done it without 40Plus.*

- In the past year, 32 **volunteer facilitators** donated over 500 hours of time taken from their busy lives to make our classes happen on 78 weekday evenings and Saturdays. Our sincerest thanks to **Rhonda Kranz** for organizing all of this activity and to all the volunteer facilitators who make the classes such a rewarding experience for participants.
- In 2017, we held **48 Monday Morning Meetings** featuring 44 unique speakers and attended by over 1,000 people. All are **free and open to the public**. - In the past year we hosted **10 Evening Networking Sessions** with speakers and light refreshments. These were attended by more than 250 incoming and outgoing class members and other guests. Our warmest thanks to **Gina Manley** and **Joy Rodman** for their unfailing good humor and making these events run so smoothly.

- In 2017, we conducted **56 Pre- and Post-class Assessments** for incoming and outgoing course participants. These mock-interview and networking sessions involved the efforts of 19 volunteers providing over 100 hours of service for which we are extremely grateful. Results indicate that, on average, our participants' skills improve by 32% and their self-perception of their skill level also improves by 35% after taking course.
- With the purchase of a little equipment and the exceptional generosity and talents of **Ron Hebensperger** and **Rand Cheadle**, we developed the capability to take **professional-quality photographs of our members**. We want all of our class participants to have a great head shot for LinkedIn and other purposes. So far we have photographed 16 class members. Thank you Ron and Rand.

- We have started to make a variety of **enhancements to our website**. You will notice that the banner graphics are greatly improved, among other things. Our great thanks to **Jim Kast** and **Dianne Williams** for helping us with this important task, and keeping us technologically operational. We have many more improvements planned.
